EMT/AEMT COURSE APPLICATION 2017-2018

Dear EMT/AEMT Course Applicant,

Emory Emergency Medical Services (EEMS) is a professional emergency medical service that provides the Emory community with vital emergency care 24 hours a day, 7 days a week while the University is in session. EEMS is a top-tier collegiate EMS organization, recognized nationally, and it was the first collegiate EMS in the state of Georgia.

In the EMT/AEMT Course, students learn life-saving patient care skills through both classroom and clinical experience. The course runs from August to April and follows the undergraduate academic calendar. In recent years, classes have been held two nights per week (Monday and Wednesday, 6-10pm) with two 8-hour Saturdays per month on Emory's main campus. In addition to classroom hours, students complete dozens of clinical hours with top EMS departments and hospitals in the metropolitan Atlanta area.

The purpose of our EMT/AEMT course is to staff Emory EMS with highly trained, licensed Advanced EMTs.

Upon successful course completion, graduates must apply for an AEMT license in the state of Georgia and volunteer for at least one year as an active member of Emory EMS. Entry into this course is a minimum two year commitment.

While this course requires considerable extracurricular work, it can be one of the most rewarding activities during your time at Emory. There is a separate tuition for the course, but it is a fraction of what local programs cost.
